

PLANNING OF EVENTS

The Sports Committee will keep in touch with the Sports Authorities J&K State as well as the Director Physical Education at the University of Jammu to know schedule of the annual events and plan for conduct of the relevant events at MIET. Inherent talent in sports and games of students who join the college in 1st semester must be tapped and the promising ones must be encouraged to participate at various levels.
