MIET Accredited With Grade "A" by NAAC



MIET became the first and only technical institution in J&K to be accredited with "A" grade by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council in 2017.



The NAAC peer team visit to MIET was the second accreditation cycle for MIET with the "A" grade reflecting the significant progress made by the institution in achieving high-quality long-term outcomes in terms of student placements, research and development, extension and outreach, industry-linkages, skill development, faculty development and engagement with stakeholders. The high-profile NAAC peer team comprising Prof. H.V Tiwary, Former Vice Chancellor of Barkatullah University, Bhopal, Prof. K.S Ramakrishna, Pro Vice-Chancellor GITAM University, AP and Prof. M.L Kothari, Professor Emeritus, Electrical Engineering, IIT-Delhi visited MIET during 12-13 October 2017 and assessed the institution on seven comprehensive

criteria laid down by NAAC. The team also visited all departments, interacted with students, faculty, staff, parents and alumni and members of the Board of Directors and Managing Committee of the college in a series of structured meetings.

International Conference on Next-Generation Computing & Information Systems

The International Conference on Next-Generation Computing and Information Systems, ICNGCIS, 2017 was organized by MIET on 11th-12th, December. The conference was sponsored by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) and the conference proceedings were published by Conference Publishing Services (CPS) of the IEEE, USA. Prof. Ankur Gupta, Director MIET presented the welcome address and described the international conference at MIET as a milestone in the development of computer science research ecosystem in the state of J&K. He reiterated the commitment of MIET to develop high-quality research capabilities in computer science and IT with international mentoring and collaboration. Prof. Manoj



S. Gaur, Director IIT, Jammu was the Guest of Honor at the conference. The conference received 97 paper submissions out of which 35 were selected as regular papers and 14 were selected as short papers for presentation on day 2 of the conference.

Prof. Sartaj Sahni, a globally recognized authority in computer science from the University of Florida, USA delivered the inaugural keynote address and spoke about time and energy efficient big data computing algorithms. The second keynote address was delivered by Prof. Sitharama Iyengar from the Florida International University on the impact of Artificial Intelligence on the future of the Indian software industry. Post lunch two keynote addresses were presented by Prof. Sharma Chakravarthy, University of Texas at Arlington on Data Science and by Prof. Vijay Kumar, University of Missouri-Kansas City, USA on the Internet-of-Things space.

The final technical session concluded with keynotes by Prof. Torsten Braun, University of Bern, Switzerland and Prof. Sanjay Madria, Missouri University of Science and Technology, USA. The day concluded with light classical performances by reputed artists of the region.

MIET Students Win Big at I3 India

Snare 3 innovation awards, Rs. 40,000 Cash Prize

Sumant Pangotra and Suave Bajaj, brought laurels to the institute and the State of J&K by winning three awards at the 9th India Innovation Initiative, a national - level innovation competition organized by AICTE, DST and CII. The team from MIET emerged winners in the two - stage competition, first finishing in the top 10 in North-India at Chandigarh and then finally emerging winners at the all-India level in a competition which was open to over 10,000 technical colleges in the country. Sumant and Suave received the AICTE Most Promising Student Innovator Award with cash prize of Rs. Forty Thousand, I3-KLU-CIIE Best Student Innovator Award and the SIDBI Incubation and Mentorship Award.

The MIET team finished on the podium among the 40 finalists, who had been selected at all India level for the finals of the innovation competition at Delhi. Sumant and Suave worked on the project, "Message Authenticity Checking System", which is a first-of-its kind veracity checking application for messages shared over mobile messaging applications such as Whatsapp and Hike etc. The application builds a database of credible news from trusted sources automatically and then allows the users to fact-check the messages for authenticity. Thus, the spread of malicious and inauthentic information is prevented. Prof. Ankur Gupta Director MIET was the project guide.





Dynamic MIET Duo Extend TATA Crucible Winning Streak

Ankur and Sanjay, final-year CSE students retained their vice-like grip on the J&K leg of the prestigious TATA crucible quiz championship, by winning it four times in a row. 


