
1. The overall discipline in the college/class is good


2. Teachers are punctual in conducting classes






5. Teachers interact with the students and answer their questions



6. The method of teaching of the teachers is effective






13. The attendance of the students in my class is good






19. The drinking water facilities in the college are adequate




21. The security arrangement in the college is good

MAJOR OBSERVATIONS / SUGGESTIONS AND ACTION TAKEN

Areas Identified	Action Taken
Up-gradation of IT Infrastructure	The institution has undertaken several initiatives to upgrade its IT infrastructure and provide better stakeholder experience: • 100 computers and 16 laptops were purchased for setting up computer labs in the law and management programs. 18 projectors have been installed in the last 6 months to ensure 100 percent ICT-enabled classrooms and laboratories. • 11 LED screens of 65" size have been installed as Digital Notice boards in all the departments along with cloud-based signage players. • 41 additional CCTV cameras have been installed for improved surveillance. • 20 additional Wi-fi access points have been provisioned for improved network coverage. • 20 KVA UPS has been installed in D Block to provide uninterrupted supply to computers and projectors for the newly created School of Law. • A 10 KVA UPS has been provisioned in B-Block to provide power backup to the new laboratory setup and projectors for the BBA/B. Com programs. A comprehensive Video Conferencing solution has been installed in the convention room for better student experience. • ICT usage has been increased to 100% in all departments. All classrooms are now enabled with ICT tools like projectors, screens, speakers etc. Labs have been renovated, new air conditioners have been installed. MIET Library has been upgraded to a new software, KOHA. It is the most advanced open-source integrated library system in use today by hundreds of libraries worldwide. It comes with a range of features, including: The Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) module, which provides a simple and clear interface for students to perform tasks such as searching for and reserving items and suggesting new items, is also useful for providing various library services to users, including the circulation of library material, cataloguing, new arrivals, etc.
Up-gradation of Physical Infrastructure	 Two new Computer Labs have been setup and commissioned in Block-D. Both these Labs comprise of 30 desktops each with latest edition of Core i5 processor, 8 GB Ram, SSD Hard drive and Internet access. To enhance the lighting and provide better experience, False Ceiling work is done in A-Block. The School of Management was given a modern look, the core values of MIET i.e, Excellence (別別), Diligence (別刊) and Innovation (司司司司) are beautifully being displayed in the corridors of the department. Digital Signage board is being used in all departments. Smart LED Displays are installed at prominent places across campus. Quality Check for water purifiers, air conditioners, fire extinguishers etc. is done under Annual Maintenance and all the machines are properly checked and verified regularly. Canteen prices have been rationalized and canteen menu has been updated.

• MIET's Controller of Examination (CoE) office underwent a comprehensive digitization process with the implementation of an ERP solution. This digitization encompasses intricate tasks such as question paper creation, admit card issuance, seat allocation, superintendent nomination, exam moderation, hall ticket generation, and result declaration. Processes like Result Declaration, applying for exam **Automation in CoE** rechecking and reevaluation, and fee payment have also been streamlined and digitized, providing students with an easy and convenient experience. The transition of student promotions from one semester to the next has become entirely paperless, contributing to the establishment of a paper-free system for advancing students to higher semesters. The Institution provides access to top-notch learning resources through exclusive partnerships and collaborations. The IOAC has collaborated closely with various departments to encourage the widespread utilization of the following digital learning platforms within the student community: **Provide Lifelong** • Coursera for Campus • Infosys Springboard **Learning Tools and Platforms** • Future Skills Prime • AWS Skills Academy All students at MIET have been provided with access to Coursera for Campus, a platform offering a wealth of educational opportunities. With this access, students can explore and enroll in over 9,000 diverse courses, enhancing their learning experience and broadening their knowledge across various subjects. In response to students' feedback requesting more Value Added Courses (VACs) in BBA (Hons.) and B.COM (Hons.), the college has taken proactive measures to enhance the offerings. The newly introduced VACs in BBA and BCOM include a diverse range of courses such as: **Provide Value Added Courses** • BFSI (Banking, Financial Services and Insurance), in BBA (Hons.) & B.COM (Hons.) • Digital Marketing with a focus on Social Media platforms (Google, Facebook, Instagram) • Cloud Computing • AMFI Certifications • Tally Certifications • Advanced Excel & Microsoft Office Suite These additions aim to provide students with a more
