MSME Workshop on Business Skill Development Organized

A one month workshop on Business Skill Development was inaugurated on 2nd Dec. 2010 under the banner of Entrepreneurship Development Cell MIET, in collaboration with Ministry of Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME). Mr Virinder Sharma, Director Micro Small and Medium Enterprises, accompanied, by Mr B.N Kapur Asst. Director MSME, were the key resource persons for the event. The event was attended by the students and faculty members of the Engineering, MCA and MBA streams from MIET. Asst Prof Neena Bhalla co-coordinator EDC cell MIET threw light on the working of EDC cell at MIET. The EDC Cell has been established under the financial assistance of the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi and aims to encourage engineering students to start their own business without being dependent on the corporate sector to provide jobs. Discussions are underway with the MSME to establish a Business Incubator Cell too at MIET.



110 Students Trained and Certified at the IBM Center of Excellence



One hundred and ten final-year students of MIET were successfully certified in leading-edge technologies at the IBM Software Center of Excellence at MIET. The online certification test was conducted by IBM at MIET following two five-day training workshops on DB2 9.7 (a Relational Database Management System) and RAD (the Rational Application Developer framework for JAVA development). MIET is the only institution in the State of J and K to have established the prestigious IBM Center of Excellence under an MoU signed between MIET and IBM. The center trains and certifies students totally free of cost. Out of the 110 students, 30 have obtained dual certification, leading to the conferment of the IBM Blue Scholar tag to these students and making them eligible to participate in the IBM Students Opportunity System, which helps them find suitable placements with IBM and its partner companies across India.

Entrepreneurship Development Workshop Conducted

Entrepreneurship Development Cell (EDC) of MIET kick-started a 22 day workshop on Entrepreneurship Development under the aegis of the Micro Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME), Govt. of India. Around 30 budding entrepreneurs from ECE and EE departments participated in the workshop, which aims to equip the students with the necessary business skills to start their own business ventures. Mr. Virender Sharma, Director MSME along with Dr. Ankur Gupta Conducted an interactive session on Entrepreneurship with the students who had varied business ideas from opening theme-based speciality restaurants to setting up organic farms to setting up software development and training companies. The open-house session saw spirited discussions on various issues faced by an entrepreneur and overcoming the fear of failure. MSME also apprised the students that they could avail of a startup grant of Rs. 6.75 lakhs under this scheme.





WIPRO Mission 10X Workshop Organized for MIET Faculty

A faculty development workshop under WIPRO Mission 10X, the faculty development initiative of WIPRO, was organized at MIET in March, 2011. The aim of the Mission 10X initiative is to enhance the teaching effectiveness of the faculty in private technical institutions in

India 10 times, thereby enhancing the capacities of the faculty and directly benefitting the students. Over 30 faculty members from MIET attended the five-day workshop which focused on the Dale Carnegie Teaching Effectiveness methodology. Faculty members were asked to plan and prepare

lessons and deliver them. They were videotaped during delivery and the lectures then analyzed to provide individualized feedback to help them improve their delivery styles. Course material specially prepared for the workshop was also shared with the faculty. The same faculty members shall now undergo a

two-day advanced follow-up workshop in the month of June, which shall lead to a more advanced level of certification. Faculty will then start creating learning material to be shared on the Mission 10X portal. Trainers from WIPRO Bangalore delivered the world-class training.

Business Skill Development Workshop for MBA Students

A 20 day workshop on “Business Skills Development” for MBA students by Mrs Shikha Chopra, Associate, Goldman Sachs, USA was organized at MIET. The workshop covered contemporary issues pertaining to global business, political and financial developments. Both the patents filed are in the domain of computer science/information technology. Chairman, MIER, Dr. Arun K. Gupta termed the filing of the two patents as historic landmark for the institution. The first patent filed by Dr. Ankur Gupta individually pertains to the domain of Network Management and aims

Detect for network faults, while the second patent filed jointly by Dr. Ankur Gupta and Mr. Shafqat Shamim, IT Manager, MIET proposes an efficient method for migrating licensed applications and associated data to a target platform with minimal user intervention. Both patents have potential commercial application, a fact acknowledged by the inventors. MIET remains at the forefront of engineering research in J&K.

Dr. Ankur Gupta Invited by Indo-US Science and Technology Forum to Present Research

Dr. Ankur Gupta was invited to present his research work at the IEEE International Workshop on Computing Over Emerging Mobile Networks, part of the IEEE Symposium on Reliability and Distributed Systems (SRDS) held in New Delhi from Nov. 1 to 4, 2010. 


With a view to hone up skills of the students and to give them practical knowledge, industrial visits were organized to various industrial houses.
