Resolved that the minutes of the 1<sup>st</sup> meeting of the Board of Studies held on 15<sup>th</sup> April 2021 and circulated to all members on 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2021 be confirmed.

2. To report on the start of new program B.E CSE (Artificial Intelligence & Machine Learning) from the current session 2022-23 with intake of 60 seats as per the approval received from AICTE.

The members were briefed about the start of new program B.E CSE (Artificial Intelligence & Machine Learning) from the current session 2022-23 with intake of 60 seats as per the approval received from AICTE. The members appreciated the vision of the institution in starting new courses in the emerging areas.

3. To formulate the curriculum/syllabi for 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> semesters of the B.E CSE program for 2020-24 batch and beyond.

Resolved that the syllabi of the 5th and 6th semesters for the B.E CSE program for 2020-24 batch and beyond be endorsed to the Academic Council for its approval. The members appreciated the following aspects of the proposed curriculum:

- 1. Introduction of skill enhancement courses including internship course of 3 credits (30 days) after the end of the fourth semester, placement specific courses in 5th and 6th semester and mini project course in 6th semester
- 2. Introduction of Python Programming and Python Programming lab in the 5<sup>th</sup> semester keeping in view of its increasing demand in the IT industry.

3. Introduction of new age courses such as Blockchain Technology and AI with

Computer Vision in the 6th semester to equip students with the skill set in

emerging domains.

4. Linkage with Coursera to offer unlimited access for the students on Coursera

platform with well-defined learning paths including guided projects and

industry certifications.

4. To formulate the curriculum/syllabi for 1st and 2nd semesters of the B.E CSE

(Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning) for 2022-26 batch and beyond.

Discussed the matter and it was resolved that the same curriculum of 1st and 2nd

semesters of the B.E CSE program as already approved by the Academic Council be

recommended for adoption in B.E CSE (AI and ML) program. The members were

apprised that the curriculum specific to the B.E CSE (AI and ML) program shall be

introduced from the 3rd semester onwards.

5. To report on the reaccreditation of the CSE department by the National Board of

Accreditation for a duration of 3 years till July 2025.

A complete report on the reaccreditation of the CSE department by the National

Board of Accreditation for a duration of 3 years till July 2025 was presented before

the members of the Board of Studies. The members congratulated the faculty

members for achieving further accreditation from NBA.
